

BRE Global EPD Hub Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

1.1 Purpose

The BRE Global EPD online tool (*EPD Hub*) is an online tool for the generation of Environmental Product Declarations (EPD) for construction products in the BRE Global EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme. *EPD Hub* allows the members of the scheme to complete an EPD template and upload the supporting information to enable verification of the EPD by the Scheme. Access to the tool is subject to payment of the Scheme membership fees and agreement to the terms and conditions described herein.

1.2 Intent

By accessing *EPD Hub*, you agree to be legally bound to BRE Global Ltd ("BRE Global") by the following terms and conditions of use and privacy policy (collectively referred to as the "Agreement"). If you are acting on behalf of an organisation, you and that organisation shall be jointly and severally liable for the obligations and liabilities described herein. If you do not intend to be bound by this Agreement or do not have legal capacity to bind your organisation to these terms you must not access *EPD Hub*. By accessing the online system you warrant and acknowledge that you have read and understand this Agreement and that you have and will continue to act in accordance with it.

2. User obligations

2.1 Compliance

You must comply with applicable laws, the Agreement (as amended from time to time), the BRE Global EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme document (SD207), and any applicable policies, procedures and guidance issued by BRE Global.

2.2 Warranty and licence

By providing information to us, you represent and warrant that you are entitled to submit the information and that the information is not in violation of any contractual restrictions or other third party rights. Where the information is confidential, you permit BRE Global to use this information; such use shall include but not be limited to verification of the information in accordance with the BRE Global EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme.

Additionally, you grant BRE Global an irrevocable, worldwide, perpetual, unlimited, assignable, sub-licensable, fully paid up and royalty-free right to copy, prepare derivative works of, improve, distribute, publish, remove, retain, add, process, analyse, use and commercialise, in any way now known or in the future discovered, any information you provide, excluding confidential information, without any further consent, notice and/or compensation to you or to any third parties. Any information you submit to us is at your own risk of loss.

2.3 Eligibility

You warrant that you meet all eligibility criteria to access *EPD Hub*, namely that you (a) have received permission of access from BRE Global, (b) will use *EPD Hub* for its intended purpose, (c) will only hold one access registration at any given time and anyone you authorise to use your access will abide by the terms of this Agreement, (d) will not violate any rights of BRE Global, including intellectual property rights such as copyright or trade mark, and (e) will provide at your own cost all equipment, software, and online access necessary to access the online system.

2.4 Indemnity

You indemnify us and hold us harmless for all damages, losses and costs (including, but not limited to, reasonable legal fees and costs) related to all third party claims, charges, and investigations, caused by or arising from (a) your failure to comply with this Agreement, including, without limitation, your submission of content that violates third party rights, (b) any content you submit for verification under the BRE Global EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme, or (c) your failure to receive critical information about the service where BRE Global has undertaken reasonable endeavours to notify you.

2.5 Payment

You agree to pay the applicable Scheme membership fees in accordance with the BRE Global EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme fee sheet (FS068) as amended from time to time within thirty (30) days plus VAT (where applicable). You shall also be liable to pay all collection costs and statutory interest for any overdue amounts.

3. User rights

On the condition that you comply with all your obligations under this Agreement, we grant you a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-assignable, non-sub-licensable licence and right to access *EPD Hub* and input, view and/or use information in accordance with this Agreement. Any other use of *EPD Hub* is strictly prohibited and a violation of this Agreement. We reserve all rights not expressly granted in this Agreement, including, without limitation, title, ownership, intellectual property rights, and all other rights and interest in *EPD Hub* and all related items.

4. BRE Global obligations

For as long as BRE Global continues to offer the EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme and you meet the eligibility requirements and other obligations set out in this agreement, you shall be permitted access to *EPD Hub*. BRE Global shall maintain the online system in good working order, rectifying bugs and defects expediently as they become known, and shall endeavour to improve the user experience and expand the functionality of the system on an on-going basis.

5. BRE Global rights

In addition to any other BRE Global rights set out elsewhere in this Agreement, BRE Global shall reserve the following rights. BRE Global may modify, replace, refuse access to, suspend or discontinue *EPD Hub*, or change and modify prices for all or part of the EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme at our sole discretion. All such changes shall be effective upon their posting on our site or by direct communication to you unless otherwise noted. For avoidance of doubt, BRE Global has no obligation to store, maintain or provide you a copy of any user-provided content. You acknowledge, consent and agree that we may access, preserve, and disclose your registration and any other information you provide if required to do so by law or in a good faith belief that such access preservation or disclosure is reasonably necessary in our opinion to (a) comply with legal or regulatory process; (b) enforce this Agreement; (c) respond to claims of a violation of third party rights; (d) enable an authorised verifier to verify the information; or (e) respond to customer service enquiries where BRE Global reasonably understands the enquirer to be a colleague or affiliate of yours.

6. Disclaimer

BRE Global provides *EPD Hub* and all information and services on an "as is" and "as available" basis and does not provide any express warranties or representations.

To the fullest extent permissible under applicable law, we disclaim any and all implied warranties and representations, including, without limitation, any warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, accuracy of data, and non-infringement of third party rights. If you are dissatisfied with *EPD Hub*, discontinuation of use and termination of this Agreement shall be your sole and exclusive remedy.

BRE Global does not guarantee that the services it provides will function without interruption or errors in functioning (whether due to maintenance, updates, system or network failures, or otherwise) and disclaims all liability for damages caused by any such interruption or errors in functioning.

7. Limitation of Liability

Except in respect of death or personal injury caused by BRE Global's negligent, or for fraudulent or wilful misconduct, BRE Global's liability to you whether in contract, tort (including negligence), statute or otherwise shall be limited to 115% of the amount actually paid by you for access and use of *EPD Hub*. BRE Global shall have no liability to you or any third person whatsoever for any loss of use, profit, revenue or data nor for any special, incidental, indirect, or consequential losses howsoever arising. This limitation of liability is part of the basis of the bargain between the parties and without it the terms and prices charged would be different.

8. Termination

Either party may terminate the Agreement and consequently your access to *EPD Hub* for any reason or no reason, at any time, with or without notice. This cancellation shall be effective immediately or as may be specified in the notice. Such termination may necessarily restrict or prohibit your use of any or all parts of the EN 15804 EPD Verification Scheme and you warrant that you understand and acknowledge that BRE Global shall have no liability to you by virtue of termination and that any fees paid shall be non-refundable unless BRE Global has terminated the Agreement for no reason or a reason other than your breach of any term of this Agreement (including failure to pay any sums as they fall due). The terms of this Agreement which by their nature are reasonably inferred to apply following expiry or termination shall survive any termination.

9. Dispute Resolution

This Agreement shall be governed by English law notwithstanding of any conflicts of law principles and all claims arising are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales except for injunctive or other urgent legal relief which may be sought by BRE Global in any court of competent jurisdiction. A party may seek to refer a dispute to the London Court of International Arbitration in accordance with its rules for resolution which shall be final and binding unless such decision is referred to an appropriate English court on a question of law.

10. General Terms

If any provision of this Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction or arbitrator to be illegal, void, or unenforceable, the unenforceable provision will be modified so as to render it enforceable and effective to the maximum extent possible in order to effect the intention of the provision; and if a court or arbitrator finds the modified provision invalid, illegal, void or unenforceable, the validity, legality and enforceability of the remaining provisions of this Agreement will not be affected in any way.

Notices shall be served to you at any address you have provided to BRE Global, or your company's registered address, unless you specify another address in writing. Notices to BRE Global shall be addressed to Bucknalls Lane, Garston, Hertfordshire, UK, WD25 9XX.

You agree that this Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between you and BRE Global regarding the access and use of *EPD Hub* and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement, unless a specific provision to the contrary exists in another effective agreement between you and BRE Global.

We reserve the right to modify, supplement or replace the terms of the Agreement, effective upon posting at <http://www.greenbooklive.com/> or notifying you otherwise.

BRE Global's failure or delay to act with respect to a breach of this Agreement by you does not constitute a waiver with respect to that breach or subsequent similar or other breaches and BRE Global reserves all rights.

No one other than BRE Global, its affiliates, you and any organisation you have effectively bound to this Agreement may enforce its provisions.

You may not assign or delegate any rights or obligations under the Agreement without the written authorisation of BRE Global. BRE Global may freely assign or delegate all rights and obligations under the Agreement, fully or partially without notice to you.
